The application for the registration of the trademark consisting of the word "MILKMAKERS" in connection with the manufacture and sale of milk was filed with the Patent and Trademark Office on the 10th day of January, 1958, and is now pending before the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board. The Board is currently conducting a hearing on the application, and a decision will be rendered in the near future.

I am sorry that I cannot advise you of the final outcome of the application at this time, but I will be glad to advise you of the result as soon as it is known.
